



Guadalupe County Groundwater Conservation District Drought Management Plan 2022


Objectives:


- The District will monitor hydrologic and drought conditions within the District and surrounding areas.
- The District will review the best available data relating to drought and precipitation within the District and the State of Texas.
- The District will review reports of permitted produced water within the District.
- The District will review rainfall data within District boundary.
- The District will obtain water levels from monitoring wells completed in the Carrizo-Wilcox aquifers located within the District's boundary three times a year.
- The District may implement drought planning.

Performance Standards:

- At each regular board meeting, the most current US and Texas Drought Monitoring Maps will be presented to the Board.
- At each regular board meeting, the District will review rainfall data obtained from TexMesonet weather stations located within District boundary.
- At each regular board meeting, the District will provide monthly summary reports of permitted produced water within the District.
- The District's Board of Directors will be provided with a report summarizing the results of measured water levels at the next regular board meeting following the completion of the report.
- The District's Board may instruct the District's Manager to take appropriate action upon determining that the District is experiencing moderate to severe drought. Possible actions to be taken may include public information releases (radio announcements, newspaper articles, or notices on website) regarding the condition of the Carrizo-Wilcox aquifers and/or notices to municipal suppliers to implement their drought management plans.
