



## Guadalupe County Groundwater Conservation District Drought Management Plan

**Objective 1:**

Each month the District will review the most current US and Texas Drought Monitoring Maps. Each month permitted water producers will report to the District the amount of water pumped. Each month the District will obtain rainfall data from gauges located within District boundaries. Three times a year (January, June and September) the District will obtain water levels from observation wells located in the Carrizo and Wilcox aquifers.

**Performance Standard:**

Each month the drought maps, production data and rainfall data will be reported to the Board. Each February, July and October the District's Board of Directors will be provided with a report summarizing the results of water levels obtained in January, June and September.

**Objective 2.**

The District's Board of Directors will monitor hydrologic and drought conditions within the District.

**Performance Standard:**

Each month the Board will review drought maps, production and rainfall data. Each February, July and October the board will review report summarizing water level changes in observation wells and graphs summarizing production and rainfall data.

**Objective 3.**

Implement Drought Planning.

**Performance Standard:**


The District's Board shall instruct the District's Manager to take appropriate action upon determining that the District is experiencing moderate to severe drought. Possible actions to be taken may include public information, (radio announcements, newspaper articles, notices on website, etc.) regarding condition of the Carrizo-Wilcox aquifer and/or notices to municipal suppliers to implement their drought management plans.
