Heavy rainfall Memorial Day weekend added to the already super saturated grounds and waterways of most of the county and surrounding areas. Guadalupe County received between 9.5"- 11" of rain for the month of May, whereas some counties received that much during one storm event. Even though Drought Stage restrictions have been lifted – everyone should still practice water conservation methods. Consider planting drought tolerant landscaping. It will drastically reduce your time mowing the yard. Capturing the rain in barrels for outdoor use is another great way to save water.








#### GUADALUPE COUNTY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT – SUMMER 2015




